 - CAUTION: Don't give the fish more attention than Jonah, and don't give Jonah more attention than God!

Isaiah 53:10

10 But the LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief; if He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see *His* offspring, He will prolong *His* days, and the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand.



"A more popular approach has been to suggest that the whole book is a literary fiction, and ought not to be viewed as historical. Although this position enjoys widespread support, it is questionable whether the author of Jonah envisaged his account as anything other than factual. Other more ingenious, but even less satisfactory, solutions have been offered. It has been suggested, for example, that Jonah recovered from his ordeal at sea by spending three days and nights in an inn called 'The Fish'." - Tyndale Old Testament Commentaries, p. 122
