#### Psalm 9:9 -

#### Psalm 27:5 -

#### Psalm 32:7 -

<sup>7</sup> You are my hiding place; You preserve me from trouble; You surround me with songs of deliverance.

#### Psalm 34:6 -

<sup>6</sup> This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him and saved him out of all his troubles.

### Psalm 37:39 -

<sup>39</sup> But the salvation of the righteous is from the LORD; He is their strength in time of trouble.

#### Psalm 46:1 -

<sup>1</sup> God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

#### Psalm 107:6 -

<sup>6</sup> Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble; He delivered them out of their distresses.
