


Doctrine of the Two Ways

Part 3 of Psalm 1



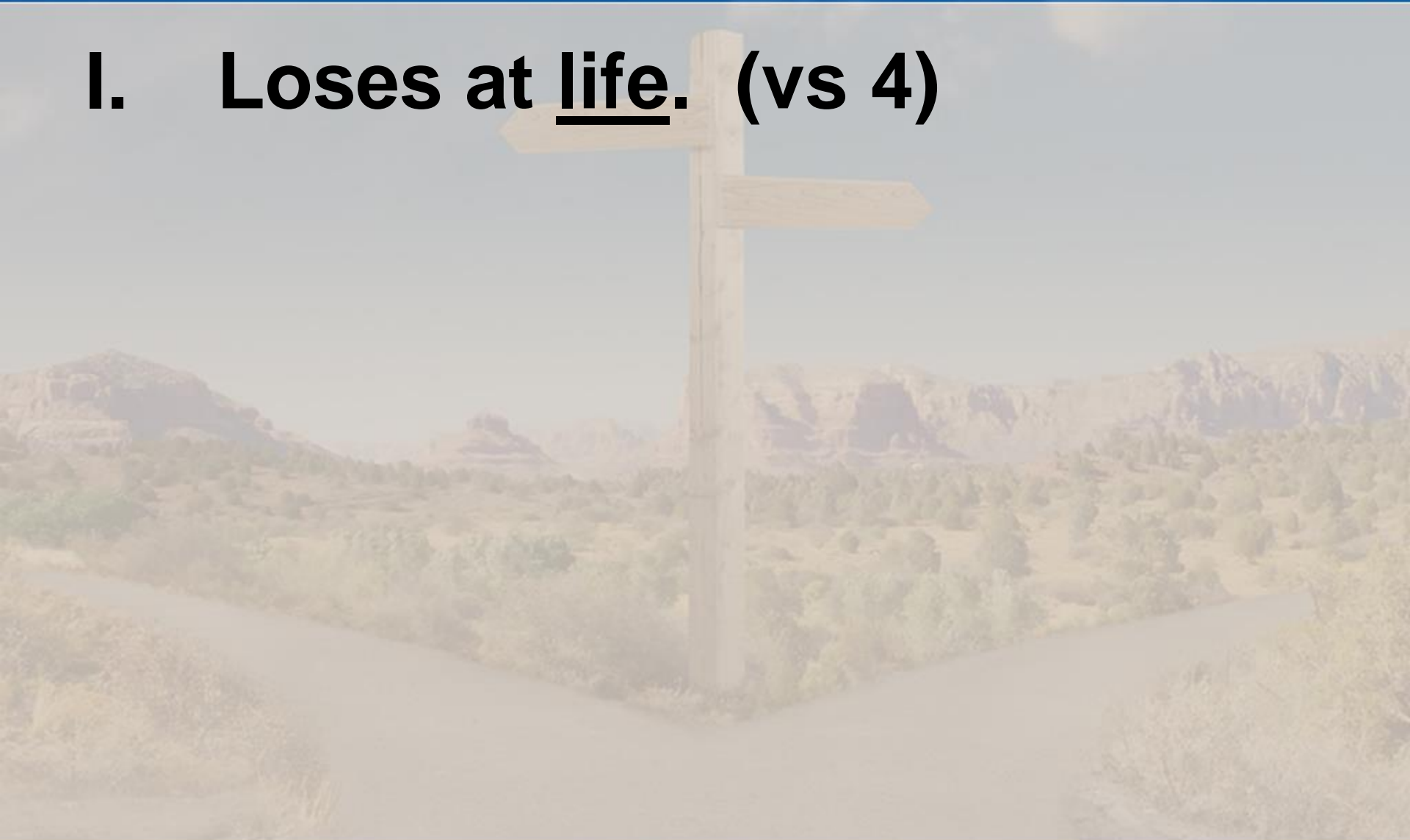
Proverbs 14:12

I. Loses at life. (vs 4)



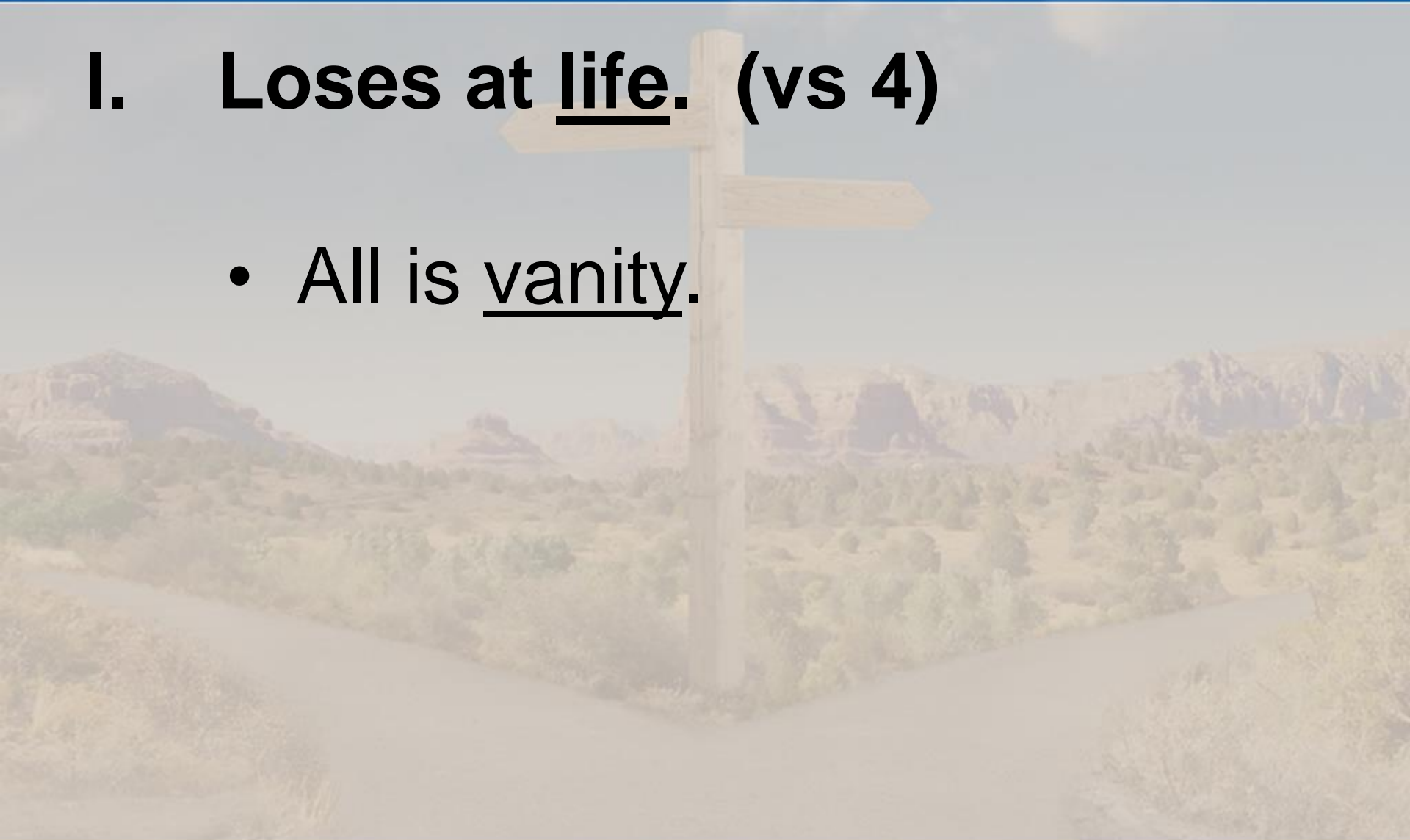

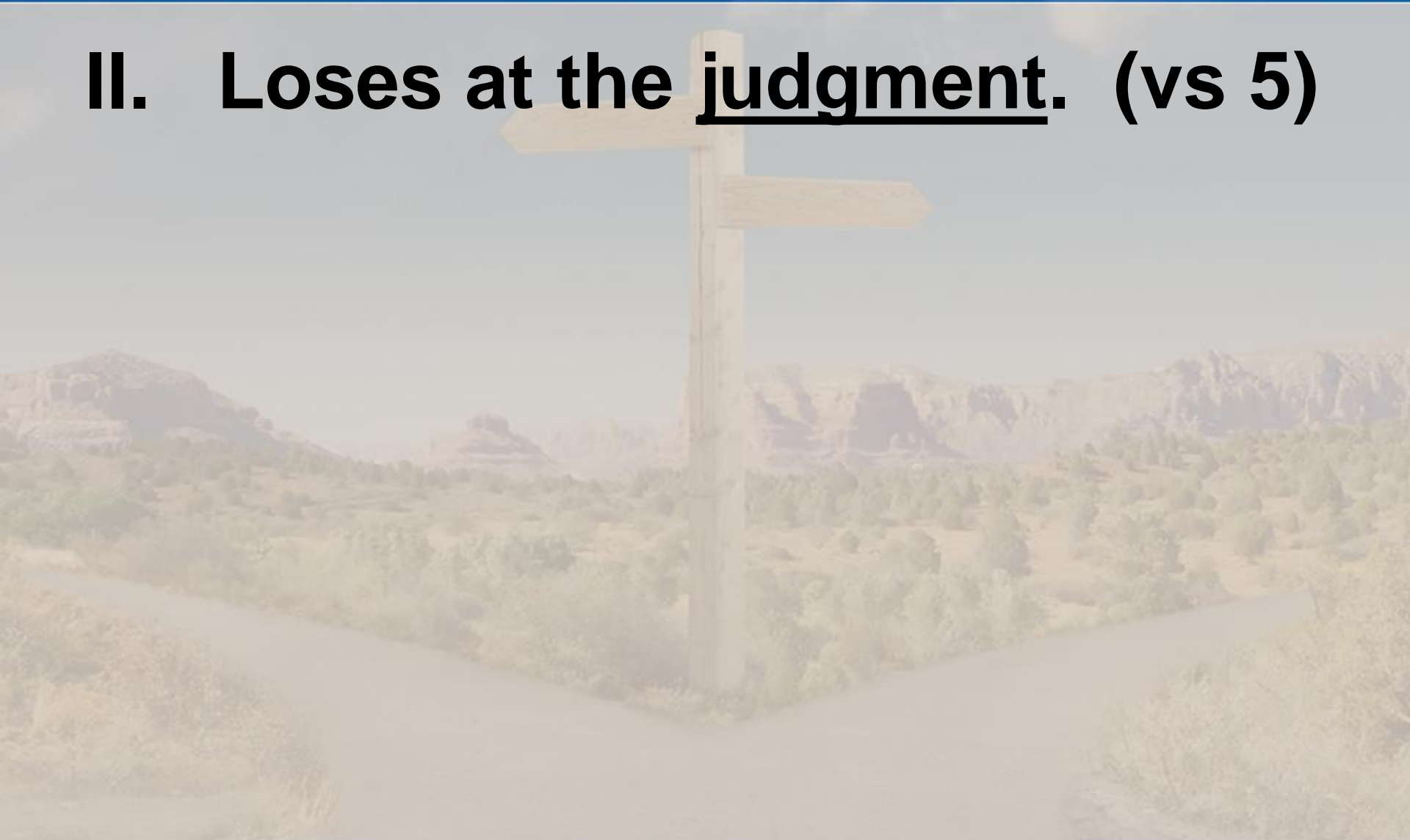
I. Loses at life. (vs 4)

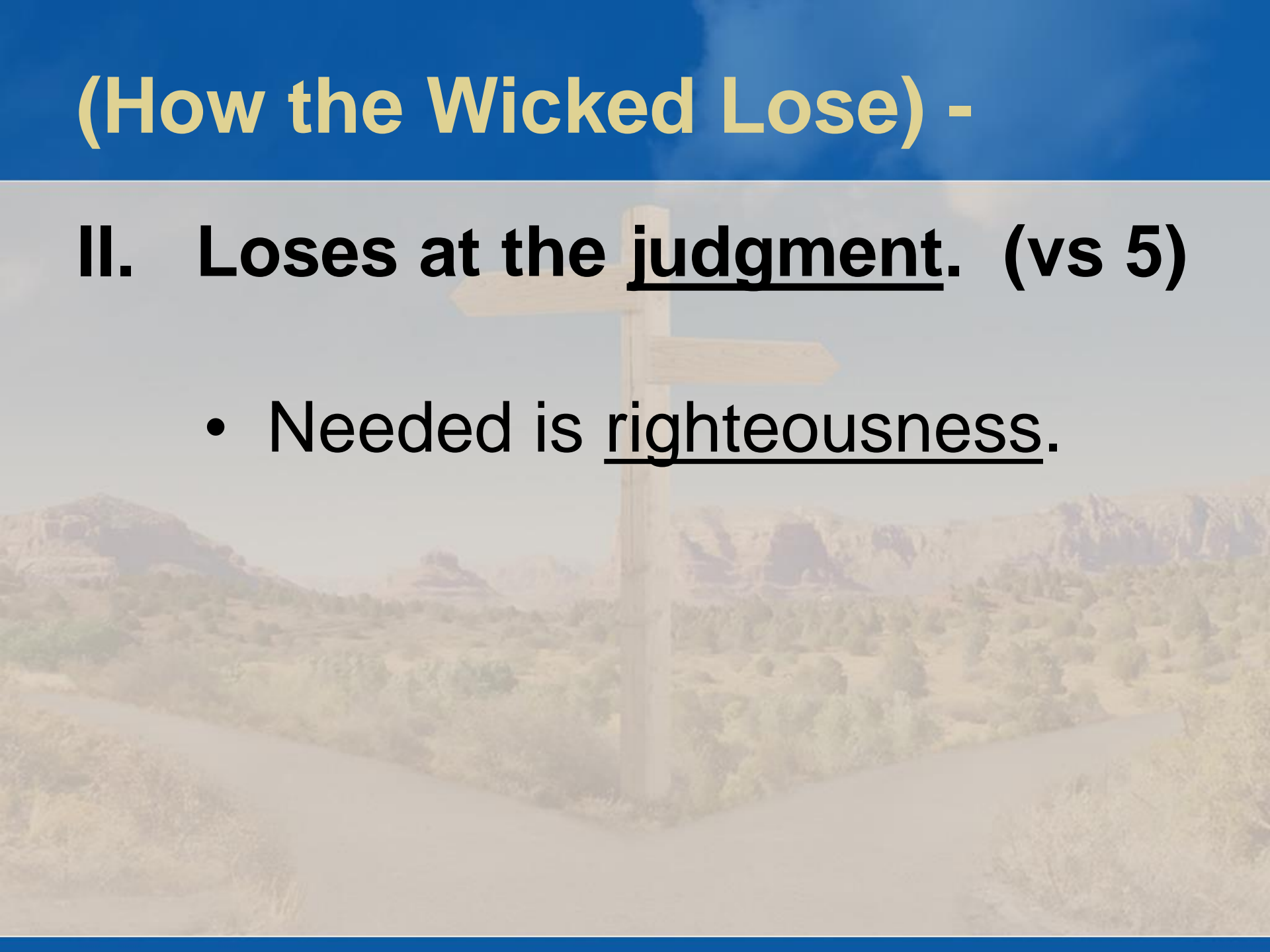

- Needed is righteousness.

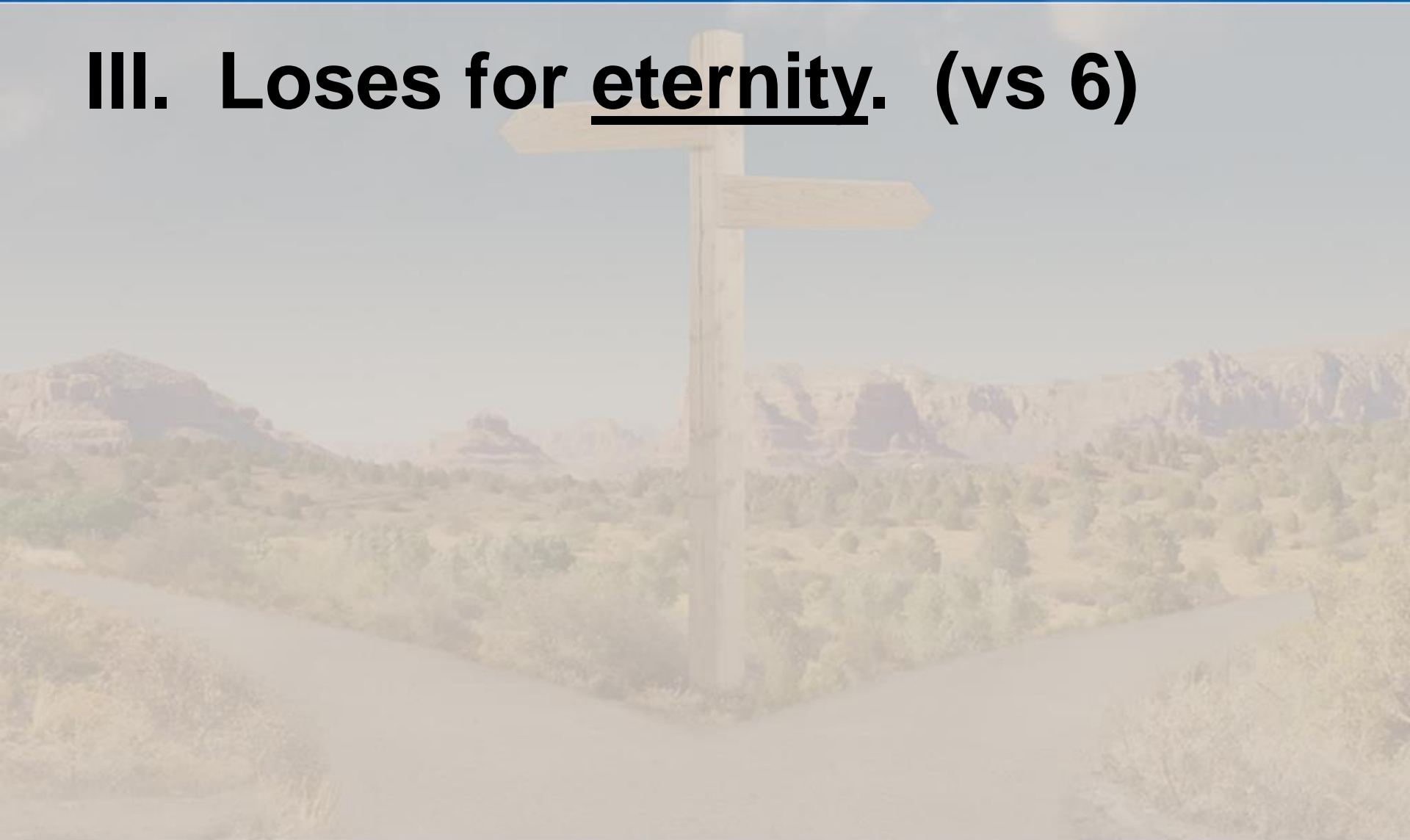


Philippians 3:9
