- Principle #1 -

1 Corinthians 4:5

⁵ Therefore do not go on passing judgment before the time, *but wait* until the Lord comes who will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness *and disclose the motives of men's hearts*; and then each man's praise will come to him from God.

- Principle #2 -

Remember to pursue peace
and building each other up.

² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
